- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the
 applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the
 institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an
 examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first
 examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL: The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session (first day of classes (___/___), or the seventh day after enrollment (seven days from date when enrollment agreement was signed(__/___), whichever is later.

If a student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund. If the student receives federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of the money's not paid from federal financial aid funds.

Application of Refund: Refund Policy: After the cancellation period, the institution provides a pro rata refund of ALL funds paid for tuition charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance. Once more then 60 percent of the enrollment period in the entire course has elapsed (including absences), there will be no refund to the student. If the student has received federal student financial aid fund, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

A registration fee of \$ 150.00 is a non-refundable item. Supplies, textbooks, uniforms, issued and received by the student are not returnable or refundable. Once received by the student it will belong to the student and be the responsibility of the student.

If you cancel the agreement, the school will refund any money that you paid, **less the \$150.00 non-refundable registration fee, supplies fee, textbook fees and uniform fee.** If you withdraw from school after the cancellation period, the refund policy described above will apply. If the amount that you have paid is more than the amount that you owe for the time you attended, a refund will be made within 45 days of the official withdrawal date. If the amount that you owe is more than the amount that you have already paid, arrangements must be made with Savvy Beauty Academy to remit the balance owed.
